HSGS Special Planning Meeting. At this meeting the following modernization and cost reduction plans were develop and will be implemented in 2004:

HSGS will acquire an additional computer for the library primarly for the patron's use of our Indexes on CD (The computer just arrived and will be set up soon).

- HSGS will no longer print hardcopy indexes for sale to the public as of this date, but will offer only all of our indexes on one CD for \$10.00 post paid.
- HSGS will sell all existing hard copy indexes in stock for 50% off. If you want a list of these request it from Mr Sherman at <shermanaj@hotmail.com>, you will be sent an email reply with the list
- HSGS will no longer maintain a hard copy of our indexes on the library shelf after December 31 2004. Patrons can use the HSGS in house patron's computer or the web site using the Park' Library Internet computers.
- HSGS will no longer publish hard copies of our monthly newsletters after December 31 2004. The newsletters will be on a web site and paid members will be given a password to use the site. The site will also contain back issues and have a search engine for searching the entire site.
- HSGS will no longer file the District Library's genealogical books with our books. Over 100 books are being returned to the original Dewey decimal location in the Library. This was done to facilitate patrons who use the district catalog, for inventory accountability, and for space considerations. All of our indexes have and introduction showing the location (Dewy Decimal Number) of the indexed book in the library.
- Acquire a High Speed Internet connection. The options are being sorted out at this time.
- Acquire a telephone for HSGS. The options are being sorted out at this time.
- HSGS is moving to a new location within the library. The current location is in the most crowed location in the library, adjacent to the Internet computers. Neither HSGS nor the patrons on the computers can do business in a normal manner without interrupting the other. This has been a constant problem in the past. The new location is much larger, and will be located in the far corner of the library from the front entrance.
- HSGS will present the active keypunchers with a thank you gift. It will be a Four-Leaf Clover Kit, so you can "grow your own good luck," and be ready for St Patrick's Day. If you are keypunching for HSGS and it does not arrive please let us known.
