The New HSGS's Patron Computer. It is up and running well. A set of instruction has been written to help patrons use it, and is kept on a clipboard by the computer. The hard copy indexes were removed from the shelves June 4th, and not one patron has asked for the hard copy indexes. A patron with some knowledge of genealogy and Windows XP & MS-Word should have no problem using this computer indexes, and then finding the original document relating to the indexes. This will allow full researching whether a HSGS member is in the library or not. For that patron without the necessary skill it is suggested they bring along a friend to help them, or come in on a Saturday 9am-3pm when a HSGS member can help them. They can also buy a CD and let a friend help them at home.
