Railroad Retirement Board (RRB). If you have a relative who worked in the railroad industry after 1936, the RRB will release records on deceased persons for genealogical research purposes. The Board will not release information on anyone still living without their written consent. The Board's records are kept by the railroad employee's social security number and a person's social security number often appears on his or her death certificate. If the number is unavailable, having the employee's full name including the middle

name or initial and complete birth and death dates may help in determining whether there is any record available

The fee for searching RRB records is \$27 for each request and is nonrefundable, even if the Board is unable to locate the information requested or if the file has been destroyed. <u>Mites, Silverfish & Cockroaches in Books.</u> One method to destroy these is to seal and freeze the book. This is from the State Library of Tasmania. An alternative method is to use the microwave. The rays will destroy any insects and their eggs, without harming the book:

- Remove any staples or metal from the books.
- One at a time, place a book in a (clean) microwave.
- Turn on "warm" for 60 seconds. (Everton Newsline June 17 2005).

<u>Tombstone Calling Card</u>. About ten years ago I had several a 3x5" cards printed using permanent black ink and sealed in heavy plastic. I glue these on family tombstone when I visit cemeteries. The card has my name & reference to me being a Sherman family historian, along with my phone, E-mail & mailing address. This research tool has work very well for me. I get several inquires each year from people who have seen these cards.

The last inquiry was from a women who was raised in New Bedford MA, and is now director of a Whale Institute in the Cooks Islands. We are both related several generations back to the same Sherman ancestor from New Bedford Ma. She found in the Cook Islands a tombstone for Mary Ann Sherman (1825-1850), wife of Capt Abner Devol Sherman (1814-1893) of the whaling ship Harrison out of New Bedford MA. Having the Sherman name in her family history she became interested in finding more about Mary Ann Sherman. Also of strange interest was the fact that Mary Ann's husband was in the business of killing whales and was in the opposite business of saving the whale.

While back in the States on vacation this spring she visited the cemetery at New Bedford and found my tombstone card. She was surprised to find another tombstone for Mary Ann Sherman (1825-1845). Further investigation uncovered the fact that when Mary Ann Sherman married Capt Abner Devol Sherman in New Bedford in 1845, and went to sea with him, that her father disowned her and placed a tombstone for her in the New Bedford cemetery. According to records Mary Ann Sherman was only the second wife to sail on a whaling boat as a Captain's wife, a custom that became quit popular in later years.

Mary Ann Sherman is mentioned in two books: (1) *Petticoat Whaler*, By Joan Druett, ©2001 and (2) *Hen Frigate*, by Joan Druett, ©1998. (By Alonzo J Sherman).
