The search engine for this site, or all of Michigan or any of the other Michigan's counties is www.rootsweb.com/~usgenweb/mi/search.htm. We currently have (Jul 31 2005) 803 indexes, 22,089 printed pages, & 987,628 names indexed. All these files are on HSGS's CD, but only 93% are on the web site (does not include new indexes within the last month, draft indexes not yet finished, & a some random data corrections). Valuable Historical Journals Online. In March 2000, the American Historical Association (AMA), the Organization of American Historians, the University of Illinois Press, and the National Academy Press created the History Cooperative to make the content of historical journals available online. While access to some of the journals is a benefit of subscription or membership to the individual organization, many are available for free to everyone.

Among the journals available at the History Cooperative are *The American Historical Review*, *The Journal of American History*, *Law and History Review*, *The William and Mary Quarterly*, *The Western Historical Quarterly*,

Common-Place, Journal of World History, The Oral History Review, and The Massachusetts Historical Review. Access is usually given to issues published since joining the cooperative. Victory for Post-1901 Canadian Census Access. For years genealogists have been waging a battle with Statistics Canada to get access to post-1901 census records. Statistics Canada refused to release the census records, and in fact wished to destroy them. This Statistics Canada could not destroy them without the consent of Canada National Archives, which they refused to permit. A battle began in Parliament to provide access to this valuable information.

On June 28 MP Dominic LeBlanc, Parliamentary Secretary to the Leader of the Government in the House of Commons, rose to move that Bill S-18 be deemed to have passed the third reading, and his motion was passed unanimously. Royal Assent was given the following day, and the bill became law.

Researchers will now have access to all Canadian census records 92 years after their creation. It has been reported that Library and Archives Canada hopes to have access to the 1911 census available online in early August 2005.
