### Rosemary E Meilock Klenow now of East Tawas died on Saturday, Jan. 27 2007.

Rosemary was born on Sept. 29, 1929, in Detroit. She and her parents, Ernest and Florence Mielock, moved to East Tawas when she was in the 10<sup>th</sup> grade. She graduated from East Tawas High School in 1946.

Rosemary was employed by the Detroit and Mackinac Railway in 1947 and enjoyed a 44-year career holding various positions in payroll and accounting until she retired in 1991. She married Robert C Klenow in 1950 and her son Blaise, was born in 1952. Robert Klenow died in 1953.

While working for the D & M Railway, Rosemary spent 30 years as local chairman of the TVU, Huron Lodge. She was treasurer and manager of the D & M Credit Union and chairman of the GTW Systems Board of Trustees. She was also an active community volunteer and contributed her time and energy to many local organizations.

Rosemary was a member and served as president of the PTO, PTA, BPW (Women of the year 1985-86). Oscoda Garden Club and Quota Club. Most recently, she was president of the Iosco County Historical Society and Huron Shores Genealogical Society and a member of Ladies Literary, Railway Business Women, D & M Historical Society and Tawas Hospital Auxiliary. Rosemary also served as the newsletter editor or columnist for many of these organizations.

Rosemary's retirement years were filled with activities that involved friends and family and community organizations. She especially enjoyed the company of her friends in the Huron Red Hatters. Rosemary spent many hours researching local history and volunteering at the losco County Historical Museum.

She also found time for acquiring many collectibles – most noteworthy were 800 collectible bears. He collection included bears from around the world, as well as bears that represented seasonal and holiday themes. It was always a challenge for her friends and family to find a unique bear that would be a gift to add to her collection.

Rosemary is survived by her son, Blaise; daughter-in-law, Carol, and grandson, Bradley. She was predeceased by her grandson, Brett.

Visitation will be held on Thursday, Feb. 1, from 2 to 4 p.m. and 6 to 8 p.m. at Buresh-Kobs Funeral Home in Tawas City. Funeral services will be held on Friday, Feb. 2, at Holy Family Catholic Church in East Tawas with the Rev. Fr. Lawrence Boks officiating. Visitation at the church will begin at 10 a.m., followed by a funeral Mass at 11 a.m. A private burial service will be held at Guardian Angel Cemetery in Rochester. Memorial donations can be made to the Iosco County Historical Society, 504 W. Bay St., East Tawas, MI 48730.
